Sector 3: Education & School

The Dicastery for the Holistic Development of Man at the Vatican has developed this platform for action to promote the ecological and social transformation of society. Planning steps:

- Start with why: Which cry from the earth or the poor do we have to answer in our specific environment?



Once a year, in the time of creation (September 1 - October 4), all participants should file a report: What do we want to achieve in the first year? What goals can we think of for the next 7 years?

Together with the 278 PILGRIM schools and institutions, we invite all teachers and schools to gather, network and exchange experiences and projects, materials and aids. For work in schools, PILGRIM has put



the 7 goals of Laudato Si and the 17 SDGs in relation to each other in order to support the concerns of the Austrian education strategy on sustainability. The goal for all projects and institutions is, as Pope Francis writes: "Let's work together for a better future!" With this campaign, the educational work within the schools is intended to support and accompany those of the public.
